Following up on the report CPIB-EC45710-20201214035744 of putative widespread and systemic corruption in Singapore research and academia:

1. A police report has been lodged on widespread and systemic corruption in Singapore research and academia, as well as recent harassment of my person at my place of residence by an individual alleging to work for Nanyang Technological University, **Singapore Police Report (NP299): Police Station of Origin:** Kampong Java N.P.C.; **Report Number:** E20201219/2035; **Officer In-Charge of Case:** E/ Tanglin Police Divisional Investigation Branch / Si Kang Bee Yan; **Officer Recording The Report:** E/ Sgt 3 Tricia Ng Chu Er; **Date/Time:** 19/12/2020 16:57.

A number of editorial boards of notable indexed journals are reviewing publications produced in Singapore for scientific invalidity, ethical oversights, disclosure and medicolegal misreporting, and 'other violations of publisher guidelines', and/or have contacted the corresponding authors in Singapore for clarification of the same.
3. Other processes are ongoing.
4. Further analyses pending.
