ORDER

UPON reading the Part 8 claim form and attached document issued by the Claimant

AND UPON the court acting on its own initiative pursuant to Civil Procedure Rule 3.4 (2)

AND UPON IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that the claim form and accompanying documents disclose no reasonable grounds for bringing the claim and/or are an abuse of the court's process or is otherwise likely to obstruct the just disposal of proceedings

IT IS ORDERED that

- 1. The claim be struck out and declared to be totally without merit
- 2. Because this Order has been made without a hearing, the Claimant has the right to apply to have the order set aside, varied or stayed. If the Claimant makes such an application, he must send or deliver the application notice with any supporting evidence to the court (together with any appropriate fee) to arrive within 7 days of service of this Order.

3. The court must serve this order on the parties.

REASONS

- i. The Claimant has failed to provide an address within the United Kingdom contrary to PD 6 para 2.3
- ii. The claim appears to allege an unparticularised conspiracy which the Claimant asserts give rise to a debt of £5,000
- iii. No proper basis for the money claim is set out, contrary to CPR 8.2.
- iv. It is apparent from the large numbers of e-mails attached to the claim form that the Claimant is seeking to complain about some form of academic misconduct alleged to have occurred at Lee Kong Cain School of Medicine in Singapore and other institutions.
- v. No proper basis for any claim against the Defendant is identified.
- vi. This is an inappropriate use of Part 8 procedure
